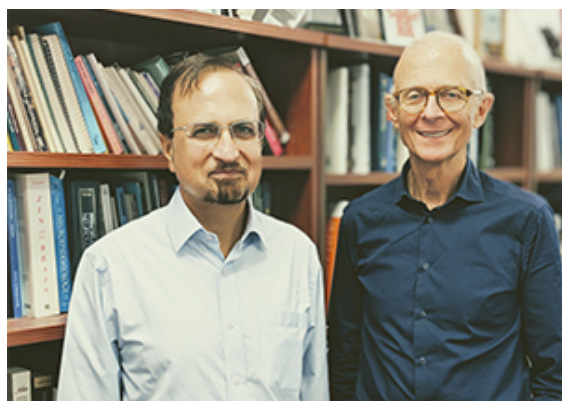




## \$2 Million to Test Diabetes Treatment to Prevent Dementia
